Introduction:

Office Bearers :-

The board of trustees may elect or nominate any one of them as the managing trustee and he/she shall hold the office for life or on his/her resignation and there after the trustees shall elect or nominate another managing trustee among the trustees. He / She will be the chief executive at all the institution working under the trust. The board of trustees shall elect among it members as Secretary and Treasurer, Who shall hold office for a period of two years but they will be eligible for re-election. The managing trustees will be the head of trust and will preside over all the meetings of the board of trustees and will regulate and will have the right to easte a vote in case of an equal division among the members in case of votiong on any point. He will have the right to initiate any motion or resolution if he so likes and speaks on any point raised by any trustee and take part in all deliberations, He may inspect any institutions or its departments belonging to the trust to see its functioning and working.

In Case of emergency the managing trustee may take decision of financial or non finacial nature in furtherance of the objectives of the trust subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.

4. Duration of the Trust : -

This trust will exist till the dissalution as per the rule laid down.

Amendments:

The rules will not be amended unless two third members of the board of trustees have agreed to the proposed amendmends.

Appointment and resignation :

The Board of trustees of the trust will / shall have power to remove any member of the trust on account of legal disability or in action or continued absence in three consecutive meeting or any misconduct or any act prejudicial to the trust by the approval of the board of trustees by two third majority.

7. Meetings: -

Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held at least twice in a year The duration between the two meetings shall not exceed eight months, extra ordinary meeting may be convened at any time by the managing trustee or by requistion of one third of total no. of members with specific agenda,

The managing trustee shall fix the date and time for meeting for the board of trustees and accordingly notice will be issued to the Board of trustees twenty one days in advance. For an emergency meeting notice will be send to the trustees by the managing trustee giving 24 hour time.

Appointment and termination of Services.

The managing trustee will have the power to terminate or suspend any employee of the trust, welfare centres and educational institutions working under the trust subject to the approval of the Board of trustees after hearing the employee concerned and giving him an opporturnity to defend himself. How ever the affected party shall have the right to appeal to the Board of trustees within 15 days from the date at communication of the order.

He shall have the power to institute conduct defend abandon any suit or action by or against the trust or refer any such matter to the arbitration after taking apporval of the board of trustees.

The audited accounts will be produced before the Board of trustees for the approval and also the proposed budget for the next year will be presented for approval by the Board of trustees.

9. Quoram:-

Half Members of the board of trustee present in person in addition to the managing trustee shall constitute the Quoram.

10. Author of the Trust shall act in accordance with the rules and regulations of the trust along with all the trustees as laid down herein till the election of the office bearers of the trust.

Function of the board of Trustees.

Subject to the provision of the rules the functions and powers of the Board of Trustees shall be as follows:-

- a To Carry, promote and advance the aims, objects and purposes of the trust as the rules laid down here in.
- To Control, direct, co-oridinate, guide and supervise all the welfare centres, institutions running under the trust.
- c. To administer and control the affairs and funds of the trust and exercise all powers of the trust.
- d. To do all other lawful acts matters things and deeds as may be conductive to or expedient in the interest of the trust.
- e. To Give approval to the action taken by the managing trustee.
- f. To Prescribed salaries, emoluments, gratuity, wages, Overtime legal and necessary charges payable to the employees at the trust and declare hodidays for persons employed in any branch of the trust;

g. To Sancition money to the institutions of the trust to meet their deficit in their annual budget as well as for other development works.

 The Board of trustees of the trust shall approve by-laws of its welfare centres and institutions before they actually come into Operation.

- It shall have power to review the working of the governing body of its welfare centres and institutions in the light of the aims and objects as laid down here in after.
- The Board of Trustees will preserve and keep the properties of the trust in proper state.
- K. Any Committee or committees to help the implemenation of the aims and the objects of the turst, may be appointed.

15. Funds of the Trust : -

The entire assets movale and immovable property received by way of grant donation or any other way in future shall Vest in the trust and shall be the property of the trust. The entire assets of any other institutions that here after be established or taken over by the trust including movable and immovable properties land or building shall vest in the trust acquired in future. The author of trust has donated Rs. 10,000/(Rupees ten thousand) and each of the four trustees have donated Rs. 10,000/= each and total Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand) in all.

The accounts will be opened in seheduled Banks only in the name of "NIRMAN" and will be operated jointly by the managing Trustee as one rignatory and any of the Secretary or Treasurer as another Signatory.

17. Aims of the trust : -

- i) To spread the literature and thinking of "NIRMAN"
- ii) To work for the social, economic cultural and Physical development of deprived people.
- iii) To make any implement programmes for the socio eco nomic development and self reliance of women, chil dren, chedule caste and schedule tribe.
- iv) To work for the abolition of child labours and for their betterment.
- v) To provide free legal aid to the women and weaker sections of the society.
- vi) To create awareness against evils such as dowry &

- vii) To Promote cultural activities.
- viii) To work for women impowerment.
- ix) Family councelling.
- To establish Centres for the treatment and counselling of drug addicts.
- xi) To work for the eradication of leprosy.
- xii) To arrange for any preventive measures in case of any contagious deseases.
- xiii) To establish Ayurvedic, Homeopathic and Allopathic institutions and get them affiliated with the concerned university Board of Council.
- (xiv) To establish technical institution for imparting technical education and training including information technology and to get them affiliated.
- (xv) To create social awareness about aids.
- (xvi) To create awareness among the people about the environmental benefits of plantation and to establish such institutions to impart training to the people in this respect.
- xvii) To help people in the event of destructions caused to life and property of the people in case of any natural calamity.
- xviii) To assist government agencies for the development and rennovation of any religious place or building or any historical place of archealogical, historical or tourist importance.
- xix) To establish art and fine art institutions.
- xx) To Start fisheries, dairy farms Bee keeping centres in order to provide employment to the weaker sections of the society.
- xxi) To establish schools and colleges for the poor.
- xxii) To establish and run public libraries and reading rooms and get them affiliated.
- xxiii) To encourage and develop para medical institutions to im part nursing training to the women of weaker section.
- xxiv) To encourage and develop educational and technical centres for the

handicapped people to improve their financial conditions and

After dissolution the total movable and immovable properties of the trust shall not be distributed among the trustees rather it shall either be given to other trust or society of the similar aims and objects after being paid all debts, loans etc. at the trust by 3/5th majority in general body meeting of the trust.
